NOW LET US KNOW ABOUT SOME EMERGENCY AND RELIEF SERVICES THAT WE GET FROM OUR NEIGHBOURHOOD PLACES.

WHAT DO WE MEAN BY EMERGENCY AND RELIEF SERVICES ?

An emergency is a situation that requires immediate action. For such situations, there are emergency services in our neighbourhood that provide us relief immediately. Hospitals, fire stations and police stations etc are examples of emergency services.

HOSPITAL : We go to a hospital for treatment when we fall ill or get hurt. A hospital has doctors, nurses, and facilities to treat patients(persons receiving treatment from a doctor) and help them get well. In case of an emergency, a special van called an ambulance is used to carry patients to the hospital. We get medicines from the dispensary of the hospital or from the chemist's shop. A small neighbourhood has a primary health centre which has few doctors who examine the patients and give them medicines.



POLICE STATION : Every neighbourhood has a police station. We go to a police station to report about a theft or a robbery. The police men protect us from all kinds of danger and keep our neighbourhood safe. The traffic police controls the traffic on the roads. A police van is used to carry police men to a place where law and order needs to be maintained.



FIRE STATION : We call the fire station in case of a fire in the neighbourhood. A fire station has red fire engines that carry the fire fighters to the site. The fire fighters use ladders and water hoses to put out fire and save lives.



TELEPHONE BOOTH AND CYBER CAFÉ : People use a telephone booth to make emergency phone calls when they are away from home.



Some neighbourhoods also have cyber cafes where people can use computers to send e-mails and keep in touch with friends and families through internet. Children go there for playing computer games.



THE EMERGENCY NUMBERS FOR THE FOLLOWING :

1. To call an ambulance : 102.
2. To call up the fire station: 101.
3. To call the police : 100.

We should keep our neighbourhood clean. Littering, spitting and writing on walls make our neighbourhood dirty.

Besides our family members and the neighbours there are many people around us who help us in our day- to- day lives. They are known as community helpers. In our next worksheet we will know about them.
