pronoun	function	examples
personal pronouns	refer to people	I, me, they
reflexive and emphatic pronouns	reflect to the personal pronoun or noun	myself, themselves
possessive pronouns	show possession	mine, yours
relative pronouns	relating to an antecedent (the noun that comes before)	who, which
interrogative pronouns	are pronouns which are question words	what, who
indefinite and distributive pronouns	refer to things in general	many, few, each, either
demonstrative pronouns	point out which	this, that, these, those
