Read:

A Noun is a word used to indicate a person, animal, thing, place or idea.

Example : Rohan, India, tiger, window, happiness, friendship etc.

Nouns can be of different types –

Common noun - A common noun is a noun that refers to people or things in general, e.g. boy, country, bridge, city etc.

Proper noun - A proper noun is a name that identifies a particular person, place, or thing, e.g. Steven, Africa, London, Monday. In written English, proper nouns begin with capital letters.

Concrete noun - It is a noun which refers to people and things that exist physically and can be seen, touched, smelt, heard, or tasted. Examples include dog, building, coffee, tree, rain, beach etc.

Abstract noun - It is a noun which refers to ideas, qualities, and conditions - things that cannot be seen or touched and things which have no physical reality, e.g. truth, danger, happiness, time, friendship, humour.

Collective noun - Collective nouns refer to groups of people or things, e.g. audience, family, government, team, jury.

Material noun - In grammatical terms, this refers to a material or substance from which things are made such as silver, gold, iron, cotton, diamond and plastic.

Countable and Uncountable nouns - In English grammar, countable nouns are individual people, animals, places, things, or ideas which can be counted. Examples are : money, children, etc. Uncountable nouns are not individual objects, so they cannot be counted. Examples are : butter, wealth, etc.
