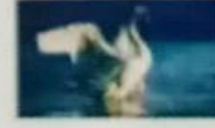

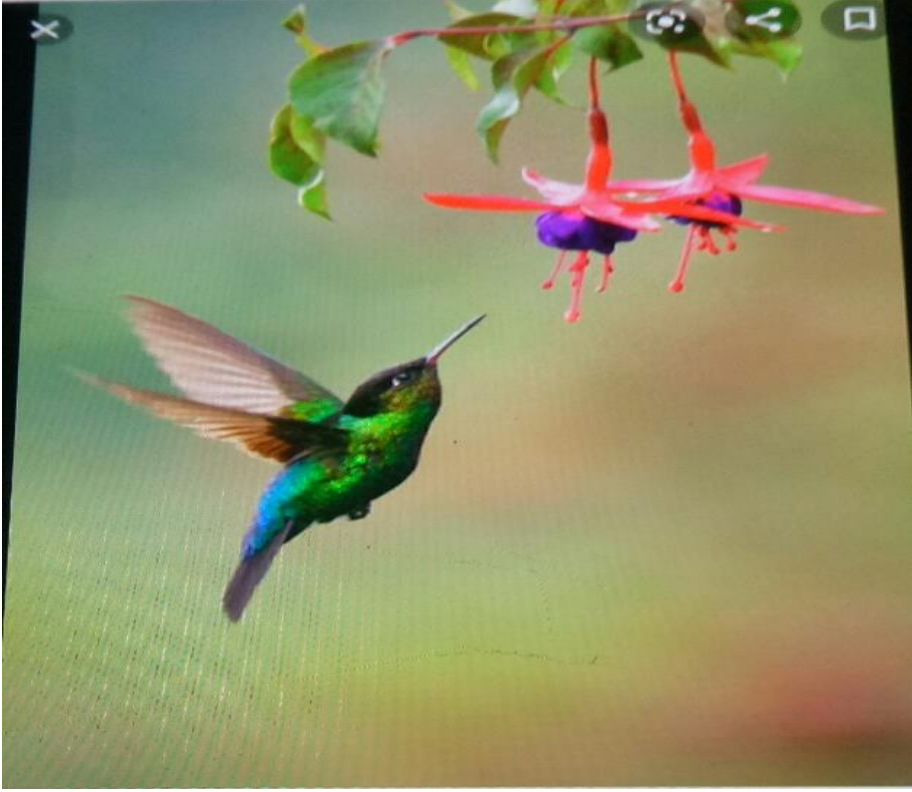

2. Some birds display a variety of colours. Birds such as the owl and the koel are black or grey while the peacock has feathers of different colours.

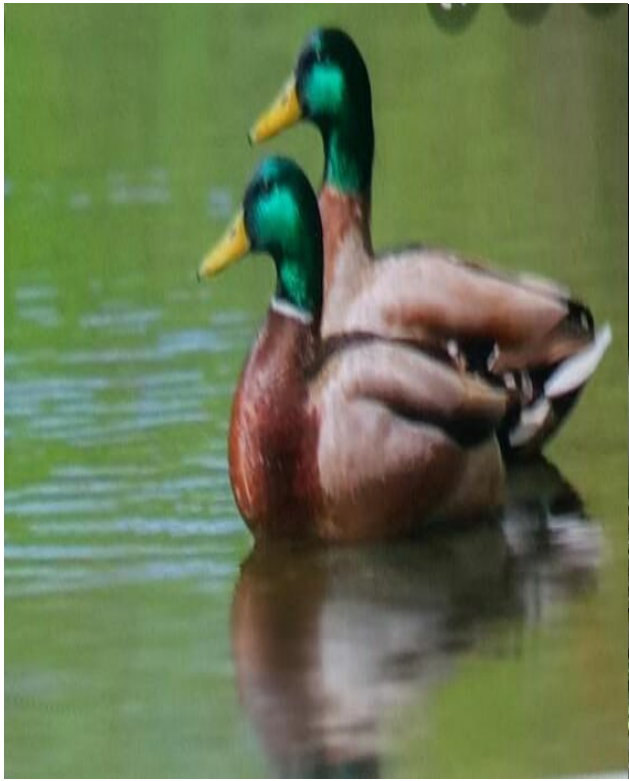
NOTE-----Owls cannot roll their eyes, they move and twist their heads to look around.



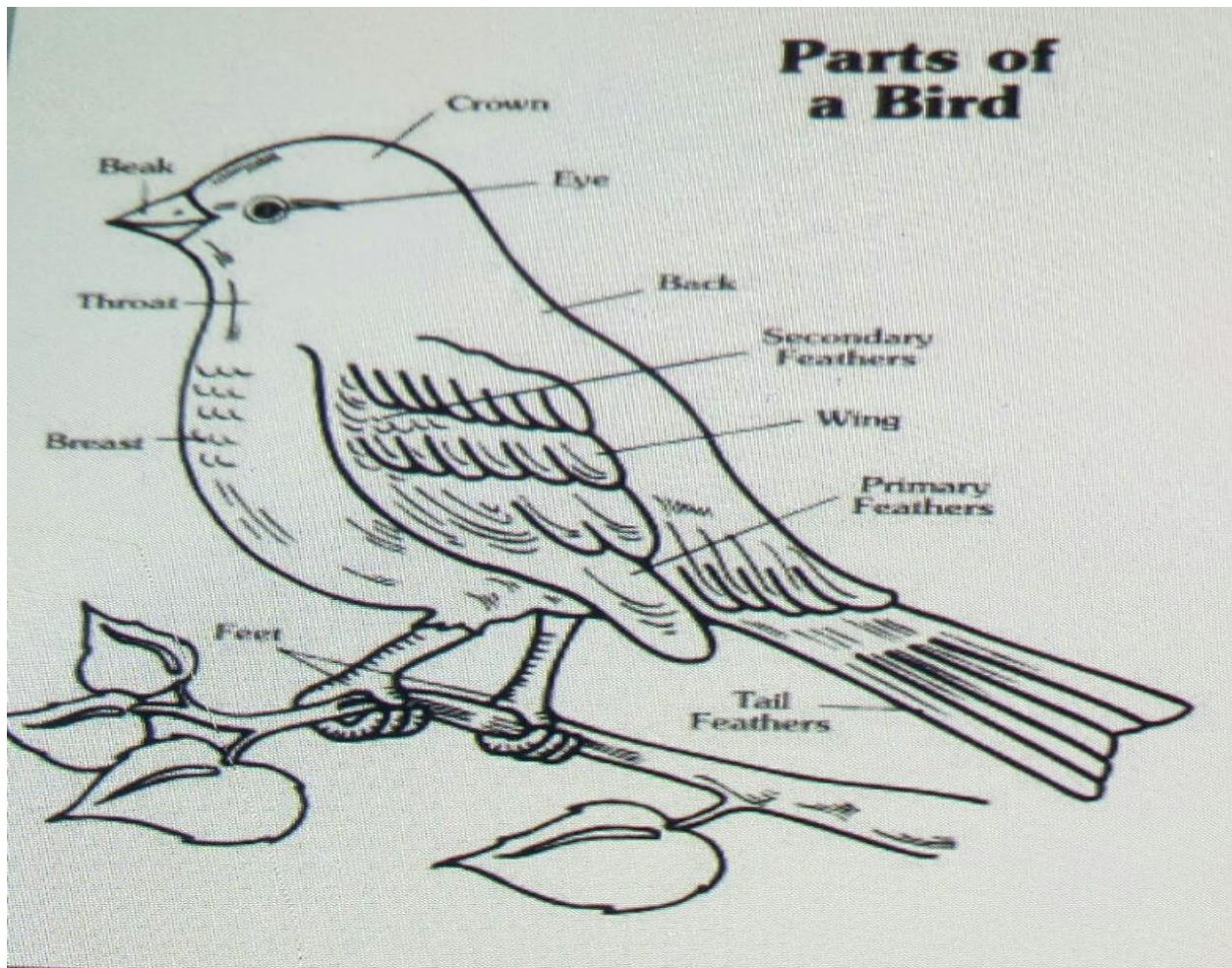
3. Some birds such as kites, eagles and vultures can fly high in the sky.



4. Some birds such as ducks, geese and cranes live in or near water.



BODY PARTS OF BIRDS



The body of a bird is streamlined which helps it to fly. The different body parts are---head, a beak, wings, feathers, claws and a tail.

- A. The wings help it to fly.
- B. The beak helps it to eat and carry materials like twigs, grass and dry mud to make nests.
- C. The wings are covered with feathers.
- D. The feathers on its body help it to fly and maintain its body temperature.
- E. The tail helps to change its direction mid-flight.
- F. The claws of the bird help it to sit on the branches and catch prey.
