ANIMAL CHARACTERISTICS:

All animals show some characteristic features. They **move, breathe, eat, grow** and **look** for **shelter.**

Animals Move: All animals move from one place to another
in search of food.

- Most animals walk on their four legs.
- Birds walk on their two legs. They fly in the air with the help of wings. [Ostriches are birds that cannot fly.]
- Fish swim in water with the help of fins.
- Earthworms, snake , snails etc move along the ground.
- Insects like ants crawl on their legs.



Animals Breathe:

- Most animals have lungs to breathe.
- Fish breathe through gills.
- Insects breathe through air tubes.




Fish with fins and gills

Feeding Habits: All animals need food to live.

Based on feeding habits, animals are divided or classified into **herbivores**, **carnivores**, **omnivores** and **scavengers**.

Herbivores: Animals like **cows** , **horses**, **giraffes**, **sheep**, **goats**, **elephants** etc eat **plants**. They are known as **plant-eating animals** or **herbivores**.

Herbivores →



Carnivores : Animals like **tigers**, **lions**, **wolves** , **eagles**, **sharks** etc kill and eat the **flesh or meat** of other animals. They are known as **flesh eating animals** or **carnivores**.

Carnivores →



Omnivores : **Bears**, **crows**, and **rats** eat both **plants** and the **flesh** of other animals. They are known as **omnivores**. **Human beings** are also **omnivores**.



Omnivores

Scavengers : Animals like **wolves, vultures** and **hyena** mostly eat the **dead and decaying** organisms. They are known as **scavengers**.
