Now let us recollect few important points:-

- **Animals are living beings that we see around us.**
- **Animals living on land are called land animals.**
- **Animals living in water are called water animals or aquatic animals.**
- **Amphibians are animals that live both on land and in water.**
- **Even on land, animals live in different places.**
- **Land animals are classified into domestic animals including (pet animals and farm animals) and wild animals.**
- **Animals move, breathe, eat food and grow.**
- **Based on feeding habits, animals are divided into herbivores, carnivores, omnivores and scavengers.**

Questions and answers:-

1. What are domestic animals? Give two examples.

Ans. Pet animals and farm animals are called domestic animals. They are very useful to us. E.g- dog and cow.

2. Differentiate between pet animals and wild animals.

Ans

Pet Animals	Wild Animals
Animals that live with us in our homes are called pet animals. E.g dogs and cats.	Animals that live in the jungles or forests are called wild animals. E.g–lions and zebras.

3. What are amphibians ? Give two examples.

Ans. Animals that live both on land and in water are called amphibians. E.g- frog and crocodile.

4. What are plant- eating animals or herbivores? Give two examples .

Ans. Animals that eat only plants are called plant- eating animals or herbivores. E.g – giraffe and elephant.

5. What is the difference between a carnivore and an omnivore?

Ans. A carnivore kills and eats the flesh or meat of other animals.

E.g- lion and fox .

Omnivores are the animals that eat both plants and flesh of other animals.

E.g- bear and human being.

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
