**Ans: It includes four stages. They are:-**

**1<sup>st</sup> stage:- egg.**

**2<sup>nd</sup> stage – caterpillar( larva).**

**3<sup>rd</sup> stage- pupa.**

**4<sup>th</sup> stage – adult butterfly.**

**7. What is chrysalis?**

**Ans: In the 3<sup>rd</sup> stage the caterpillar wraps itself in a hard covering called chrysalis and changes into pupa.**

**Ans: A dog's hair protects the animal from extreme weather conditions.**
