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Singular and Plural

Nouns tell us about the **number** of things they name.

Nouns that refer to one person or thing are called **singular nouns**.

a flower, an ice cream, a boy, a tiger

Nouns that refer to more than one person or thing are called **plural nouns**.

rivers, bodies, benches, toys, girls

We can change singular nouns into their plural forms in many ways.

We add **-s** to most nouns to form plurals.

nut ~ nuts

flower ~ flowers

A Add **-s** to the following nouns to form their plurals.

1. balloon
2. present
3. friend
4. museum
5. elephant
6. Wednesday

7. biscuit
8. building
9. office
10. desk
11. clock
12. escalator

We add **-es** to some nouns that end in **o, s, ss, sh, ch** and **x** to form their plurals.

hero ~ heroes

class ~ classes

bush ~ bushes

beach ~ beaches

tax ~ taxes

Nouns that end in -y

If the letter before the *y* is a consonant, change the *y* to *i* and add *-es*.

baby ~ *babies*

city ~ *cities*

If the letter before the *y* is a vowel, just add *-s*.

key ~ *keys*

boy ~ *boys*
