- a) travel - Nomads **travel** from place to place to find fresh grazing grounds for their cattle.
- b) trudging - The old porter is **trudging** along, carrying heavy luggage on his head.
- c) unkind - Our rude behaviour, sometimes, reflects our **unkind** nature.
- d) dull - All work and no play makes children **dull**.
- e) stand- The mountaineers couldn't **stand** the harsh climate and they died.  
(here **stand** means to bear or endure, as it is given in the poem)
