


The orchards in their farm have rows of papaya trees. Their branches are full of fruit. Raghu and his mother pluck a basketful of **ripe**, orange papayas.

are his favourite cows.


They moo when they see him and **flick** their tails. ‘Pyari and Munia, see , I have brought grass for you’, Raghu says. He feeds them handfuls of grass.
