Come on children, let me take you to the **animal kingdom** today:

Introduction: Our Earth is a home for many kind of animals. They are living beings that we see all around us. Some animals are **big** and some are **small**. Animal kingdom is wonderful. It is very important for us to know about their **behaviour** pattern and **living** pattern. They have different **feeding** habits and **most** of them give **birth** to young ones.

Types of animals: Animals differ in their **shapes, sizes, habits** and **habitats**.

Some animals live with us in our **homes** while some animals live in **jungles**. The place where an animal lives is called its **habitat**. Animals living on **land** are called **land animals** and animals living in **water** are called **water animals**. Animals living **both** on **land** and in **water** are called **amphibians** .

Brief description of different types of animals:

LAND ANIMALS

Animals living on **land** are called **land animals**. Even on land , they live in different places. Different types of land animals are:-

Domestic animals : Animals like **cats, dogs, parrot** etc that live in our **homes** are called **pet animals**.


Some animals like **cows, buffaloes, hens, duck, sheep, goat** etc are kept on **farms** and are very useful to us. They are called **farm animals**.

Pet and **farm** animals are called **domestic animals**.

DOMESTIC ANIMALS



FARM ANIMALS

Wild animals : Animals that live in forests like **lions, tigers, wolves, fox** etc are called **wild animals**.



WILD ANIMALS

Some animals like **monkeys** , **birds**, **squirrels** etc live on **trees**. **Camels** live in hot **deserts**, **polar bears** live in very **cold** regions.



AQUATIC ANIMALS/WATER ANIMALS :

Animals like **fish**, **dolphin**, **octopus**, **whale**, **shark** etc live in **water** and are called **water animals** or **aquatic animals**.

AMPHIBIANS :

There are some animals that live both on **land** and in **water** like **frog**, **toad**, **crocodile**, **alligator** etc. They are called **amphibians**.




Shelters for animals :

Like us , animals also need homes to protect themselves from heat, cold rain and other dangerous animals.

Different animals have different homes

1. Lions live in dens
2. Bears live in caves.
3. Snakes and rabbits live in holes and burrows.
4. Honeybees live in beehives .
5. Giraffes and zebras live on grass lands.
6. Horses live in stables.
7. Cows live in sheds.
8. Hens live in coops.
9. Pet dogs live in kennels.
10. Birds make nests to lay eggs and to keep their babies safe.
11. A goat lives in a barn.
12. Ants live in ant hills.
