Topic: Just Imagine (Poem)



Good morning children...

Today we will begin with another new poem. I hope all of you will like it a lot. Often we think about things in a different way. How would the world be if things that we see around us become different? Have you ever thought about it? Imagine a bird wearing a school uniform or imagine yourself flying like a bird. This is actually imaginative thinking. It is good be imaginative because imagination often gives birth to invention. Today, I will teach you a poem where the poet imagines differently. Here is the poem 'JUST IMAGINE'.



These are the first two stanzas of the poem.

In the first stanza the poet's imagination reaches a crocodile's teeth. She thinks about brushing the teeth of a crocodile in the same way as we humans do. The poet thinks and asks how many tooth brushes will be required to brush the teeth of a crocodile to keep it shining. It is because, we all know that a crocodile has more teeth than what we have and their teeth is much bigger than ours.

In the second stanza, the poet thinks about the elephant. She imagines the situation when the elephant sneezes. We all use our handkerchiefs to cover up our nose and mouth while sneezing. But have you ever seen an elephant using a handkerchief to cover up while sneezing? It seems very funny, isn't it? The

poet imagines the number of handkerchiefs an elephant must be needing if it had to cover up its nose while sneezing. Then it also had to wash those handkerchiefs and fold them.

I hope all of you have understood the first two stanzas of the poem. Now, all of you have to read the poem aloud with proper pronunciation. Then you will have to learn these two stanzas by heart.

There is a notice for you children. Now onwards whatever written work you will be asked to do, you will have to do it in the notebooks that you will get from the school.
