th has 2 sounds. (1) **th** as in think thing thin myth (2) **th** as in this those that them

sh has 1 sound, as in shop shed shave or wash dash fish.

ch has 3 sounds. (1) **k** as in school chemist echo (2) **sh** as in champagne chef (3) **ch** as in chop chain such much
Note: In some words it says **tch**, e.g., much rich such which.

ck says **k** and only comes after a short vowel, as in pick packet lock bucket.

Two Letters Make One Sound Ending

ew has 2 sounds.
(1) long **u** as in few knew threw
(2) long **oo** as in blew drew flew

ed forms the past tense of regular verbs. It has 3 sounds.
(1) **t** as in picked lacked
(2) **ed** as in shaded folded
(3) **d** as in loved scrubbed

ow has 2 sounds.
(1) **ow** as in how cow now
(2) long **o** as in throw show know

ng says **ng** as in bang bring finger strong.

ey has 2 sounds.
(1) long **e** as in trolley key monkey
(2) long **a** as in prey grey they

ea has 3 sounds.
(1) short **e** as in bread head read
(2) long **e** as in meat dream
(3) long **a** as in break great
