- At the school office counter: 9:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. (Monday to Saturday)



- 1. The school fee cover twelve calendar months and are to be paid in monthly installments. No reduction in fee is permissible for holidays. Students are liable to be charged the full fee as long as their names are officially on the school rolls. Fee once paid will not be refunded.
- 2. Pupils whose fee are overdue may be barred from appearing for examinations and their names may be struck off the rolls.
- 3. Fees for holiday months must be paid in advance before the school closes for holidays.
- 4. Fee must be paid on or before the 8th of each month without fail. A fine of ₹100/- will be charged on fee paid after the 10th of the month.
- 5. The school reserves the right to increase fee if necessary.

Withdrawal & Dismissal

- 1. Parents/Guardians must give at least one month's notice before withdrawing a student from the school. All dues must be cleared on the date of the application.
- 2. Transfer Certificates will be issued only upon receiving a TC fee equivalent to one month's tuition fee.
- 3. No certificate will be issued until all dues to the school are cleared. A written application from the Parent/Guardian is required for issuing a certificate.
- 4. Students who exhibit irregular attendance, habitual lateness or absenteeism, disobedience, disorderly conduct, or conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school, or who have illnesses deemed harmful to others, may be dismissed with prior notification.
- 5. Dismissed students will not be re-admitted.
- 6. The School Authority's decision is final in all cases of dismissal and withdrawal.





General Instructions

- 1. It is obligatory for parents/guardians to abide by the rules and regulations of the school, which may be amended from time to time.
- 2. In matters of academics and administration, the Managing Partner's decision is final.
